This includes but is not limited to the following:

- * repairing, painting and patching exterior walls.
- * repairing, painting and patching roof tops.
- * replacing window screens.
- * plant replacement.

The Association provides generic landscape service in the front yard areas with the resident's understanding that limited capabilities exists with the provided hired landscape service in terms of height restrictions and basic landscape maintenance. Any growth above the hired service's ability to trim and/or remove, is and always the responsibility of the residential owner.
