## **Tucson National Townhomes West**

## - Prohibited Plant List -

- 1. In privacy areas, any species of tree whose mature height may reasonably be expected to exceed the approved building height and threaten to damage neighboring residents may be prohibited, with the exception of those species specifically listed as approved by the Association Architectural Review Committee.
- 2. In all areas, Olive trees (Olea europea) will be prohibited because of their allergy producing pollens.
- 3. In all areas, all varieties of Mulberry (Morum species) will be prohibited because of their allergy-producing pollen.
- 4. In all areas, common Bermuda Grass (Cyondon dactylon) will be prohibited because of its allergy-producing pollen. Lawns and irrigated ground covers will be limited in use to areas confined by walls. Hybrid Bermuda grasses will be acceptable. Grass types shall be included in Architectural Review Committee submittals.
- 5. Other plant material may be subsequently added to or deleted from this list as determined appropriate for the community by the Architectural Review Committee.
- 6. Other plants as prohibited by the Tucson National Townhomes West Association.
